Registration

The congress registration is only possible online. Every participant is responsible for the correctness of the given data. The payment of the registration fee has to be made online during the registration process using the payment methods provided. A submitted registration is binding.

The congress ticket includes

- A name badge
- Access to all scientific sessions
- Access to the pre-booked Sunday programme
- Access to the ePoster exhibition
- Access to the industry exhibition
- Access to the industry symposia and live surgeries
- Free access to the ESGE Congress App
- Coffee and lunch breaks (snacks and refreshments)
- Invitation to the Welcome Reception
- Certificate of attendance & CME-CPD certificate

ESGE members

To be entitled to register at the reduced ESGE member rate, the attendee has to have a paid current ESGE individual membership (ESGE membership number will be requested and checked) or a current membership in one of the ESGE Corporate Member Societies - AGE, BSGE, SCGP, SEGI – (membership status will be checked) before starting the registration process. Membership must be valid at the time of the ESGE 31st Annual Congress.

Change or cancellation of registration

The participant must inform the congress organiser immediately about any change of registration. All changes and cancellations must be submitted in writing to: esge@eurokongress.de

Cancellation fees up until Friday, 26th August 2022:

- Congress tickets / Sunday-only tickets: EUR 75.00 (incl. 23% PT VAT)
- Pre-Congress Course: EUR 50.00 (incl. 23% PT VAT)
- Cadaveric Dissection Demonstration: EUR 50.00 (incl. 23% PT VAT)
- Congress Party: Non-refundable

From this date onwards or in case of a no-show, registration fee reimbursements are no longer possible unless the organiser is provided with a named replacement who will take on the registration.

Cancellation of the onsite congress

In the event that the onsite congress cannot be held due to a situation of force majeure or cannot take place to the planned extent, such as pandemic contact restrictions, the organisers reserve the right to change the congress format into a fully virtually congress. Every onsite registration will then automatically be changed into an online registration.



Name badge

Upon arrival at the congress venue all participants will receive a name badge, which must be worn visibly for the entire duration of the congress. It is not possible to collect a badge for another participant. The name badge acts as a personal entrance ticket for the congress and is non-transferable to other persons. Please be aware that badges will only be handed out if the registration fee is fully paid.

CME-CPD Credits (EACCME)

The congress will apply for CME credits (ECMEC) by the European Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education (EACCME). In accordance with the EACCME rules & regulations, the following procedure is obligatory to obtain your CME-CPD Credits:

- 1. Collect your name badge**
- 2. Scan your attendance onsite**
- 3. Complete the evaluation form**

Due to the regulations of EACCME, you will not receive your certificate if you do not complete the evaluation in time.

Access to the congress / industry exhibition

All attendees must be over the age of 18.

Registration is only allowed for health care professionals, industry representatives and other stakeholders in the field of endoscopy. Attendees might be asked to provide a proof of status (e.g. ID card, confirming letter of workplace) when requested.

There might be restrictions to access certain areas of the industry exhibition due to regulations for advertising of pharmaceutical products to non-healthcare-professionals or non-prescribers.

Due to compliance regulations all non-registered persons (family members, accompanying persons) are not allowed to access the congress and the industry exhibition.

Any participant with signs of illness indicating an infection with COVID-19 (fever, cold, cough or similar) or participants that have been diagnosed with COVID-19 within the last 14 days are not allowed to enter the congress venue.

This rule also applies to participants that have been in contact with a person, who is infected with COVID-19 (documented or assumed). This exclusion does not apply to health care professionals who have professional contact with COVID-19 patients as long as all relevant safety measures were respected.

Every participant registering for the congress confirms that the above mentioned conditions will be fulfilled.

Photography and recording

We reserve the right to use photos and moving images taken during the congress.

All presentations and lectures are intellectual property of the authors and thus no audio or video shall be recorded or broadcasted at any time by the participants.

In accordance with the authors the scientific programme will be recorded by the organizers and provided as on-demand video. Please note that any speaker or delegate asking a question might be recorded together with the running session.



The recordings may be published by ESGE or its appointees on the ESGE or any of its affiliated websites or in any other ESGE or affiliated publications.

Programme changes

Any last minute changes due to functional, private or organisational reasons will be announced on the congress website. The event organiser accepts no liability for any additional costs caused by a change of programme.

Disclaimer

Neither ESGE nor EUROKONGRESS GmbH shall be liable for accidents, bodily injury, and theft as well as for additional costs due to the change of the event date, location, and programme or similar.
